PREPARATION FOR EXAMS:

Phones and Other Electronic Equipment:

If you have a phone, smart watch or any other electrical device, it must **turned off**, and either **placed in your bag**. Your bag should be secured in your lockers (and not brought into the exam hall).

Please note: You are solely responsible for the safety of your phone or any other of your belongings.

Other Books, Notes or Revision Materials:

Do not bring any unauthorised books, notes or papers to the exam hall.

Equipment list:

Please make sure that you bring the following items in a clear plastic pencil case/bag, to **every** exam:

- Black Biro x 2
- Pencil x 2
- Pencil Sharpener
- Rubber
- Ruler
- Highlighter
- Scientific Calculator – memory cleared for every exam (calculators can be purchased from the finance office at a very competitive price, should you need to purchase one).
- Compass
- 180° Protractor

You are also allowed to have a **clear plastic water bottle** with **no labels** in the exam.

Please note: **You must check you have all necessary equipment**. Your equipment is your responsibility and will be required in order to complete certain exam tasks.

ON THE DAY OF EXAMS:

Entering the Exam Hall/Room:

- You must be at the sports hall 10mins **before** the time stated on your exam timetable. The time stated on your timetable is the **actual start time of your exam**.
- **DO NOT BE LATE.** If you know you will be late for any reason, please contact the main school reception either in person, or by telephone (if prior to a morning exam).
- You must wait outside the sports hall and only enter once the exams officer or an invigilator instructs you to do so.
- Be aware that other students may have already started their examination prior to you entering. Therefore find your place as instructed, **in silence**. Your name will be on your exam desk. *A plan should be available for you outside the sports hall, prior to exam entry. Please check this before entering the sports hall.*

During the Exam:

- Do not mark the exam desks in any way.
- Silence must be observed at **all times** in the exam room, without exception. This applies to **all pupils**.
- If you wish to ask anything, put up your hand and wait for one of the invigilators to come to you.
- Do not touch or turn over the exam paper until you are told to do so. When instructed, read the front cover of the exam paper very carefully and fill in all parts, as appropriate.
- You will be told when to begin the exam and when the exam is over (times will be written clearly on boards at the front of the hall).
- **Do not doodle on the exam papers or answer sheets.** It is an offence to do so in an exam and may result in the loss of marks for that exam, as instructed by the exam boards.

After the Exam:

- If you finish early, read through the exam paper **at least twice** carefully to proof read and to double check your answers.
- Once the exam is over, **sit in silence while the papers are being collected.**
- The exam will last for the stated time and you will have to stay seated and silent for the whole length of the exam.
