



## St Bede's Inter-Church School Uniform

It is important for all students to come to school dressed smartly. We feel that it gives students a sense of well-being and enables them to identify readily with our school. All students are expected to arrive at and leave school in their main uniform. The school will exercise reasonable discretion with regard to students' presentation, including matters not explicitly covered in the uniform code.

### Main uniform

- \*Blazer
- \*Tie
- \*jumper or cardigan
- Tailored black or charcoal grey trousers (not tight-fitting)
- Black or charcoal grey stitch-pleated skirt to be worn knee-length
- Tailored black or charcoal grey school shorts
- Blue long or short-sleeved shirt
- Plain black socks or black opaque tights
- Formal black school shoes with black soles and no logos. Trainers, boots and canvas shoes are not permitted

### Sports kit

- \*Short-sleeved shirt
- \*Shorts
- \*Tracksuit bottoms
- \*Rugby top or half-zip top
- \*Long socks
- Indoor trainers with non-marking soles
- Outdoor trainers or studded boots

Shirts, trousers, shorts and skirts are widely available but must be of an identical style to those displayed on the Total Clothing website. Second-hand uniform and sports kit is available from the School Office.

### Hair styles, jewellery and make-up

- Earrings should be limited to small studs
- Necklaces must only be worn inside clothing removed for PE and practical subjects
- Rings should not be worn
- Nose studs and other facial jewellery are not permitted
- Make-up and coloured nail polish should not be worn
- Long hair should be tied back for practical lessons
- Hair colouring should only include natural shades
