To revise the content

- □ Use the **revision clocks** to summarise each topic and ensure all areas are covered.
- □ Do the activities and exam practice in the **My Revision Notes guide** then check using the answers in Teams (or ask your teacher if advice needed).
- □ Check you are up to date on <u>Educake</u> quizzes set by your teacher (be careful if picking your own as they might not be on topics you are likely to need for your exams).
